1. The product is from the country of origin indicated in the document.
2. The product was obtained from federally inspected slaughter plants or rendering plants.
3. The maximum content of insoluble impurities in the tallow does not exceed 0.15 percent of its weight.
4. In the country of origin of the product there exist animal health regulations in force that prohibit the feeding of ruminants with meals made from meat and bone or skin rinds of ruminant origin.
5. The animals from which the product was obtained were not stunned by means of gas injection in the cranial cavity, or cutting of the spinal cord by laceration of the central nervous tissue by means of introducing a sharp cutting instrument in the cranial cavity.
