Export Requirements for Bulgaria

Eligible/Ineligible Products

A. Eligible

1. Poultry and poultry products.
2. Red meat and red meat products.

B. Ineligible

1. The restriction on beef and beef products originating from slaughter, cutting, processing or cold storage establishments located in the state of Washington has been removed.*

Documentation Requirements

- A. Beef products - Obtain FSIS form 9060-5 (7-19-2001), Export Certificate of Wholesomeness and FSIS Form 9265-3 (03/18/2003), Health Certificate for Fresh Meat of Bovine, Ovine, and Caprine Species, and For Forestomachs Therefrom.
- B. Pork products - Obtain FSIS Form 9060-5 (7-19-2001), Export Certificate of Wholesomeness and FSIS Form 9265-2 (03/18/2003), Health Certificate for Fresh Meat of Porcine Species and Offals.
- C. Poultry Products - Obtain FSIS Form 9060-5 (7-19-2001), Export Certificate of Wholesomeness and FSIS Form 9265-1 (03/18/2003), Health certificate for Fresh Poultry Meat and Offal's.

Note: The State(s) from which the birds originated must be indicated in the blank after "Region" in statements 1 and 2 of FSIS Form 9265-1.

- D. Meat and Poultry Products - Obtain FSIS Form 9060-5 (7-19-2001), Export Certificate of Wholesomeness and FSIS Form 9265-4 (03/18/2003), Health Certificate for Meat Products and Poultry Meat Products.
- E. All FSIS certificates must be dated and bear the signature and title of an FSIS veterinarian.

Other Requirements

- A. Raw pork meat intended for export to Bulgaria must be subjected to a freezing regimen according to 9 CFR 318.10(c)(2) for destruction of trichinae. Alternatively, the product may be frozen for 12 days at minus 30 C or for 25 days at minus 25 C. It is also acceptable to test the pork for trichinae in lieu of

freezing the product.

Plants Eligible to Export

All Federally inspected establishments are eligible to export to Bulgaria.

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
