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Export Requirements for Lebanon

Eligible/Ineligible Products

A. Eligible Products

1. Poultry and poultry products (see restriction below).*

B. Ineligible Products

1. Beef meat and all derivatives.
2. Poultry and poultry products from the States of Texas, Delaware, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.*

Packaging/Labeling Requirements

Processed meat/poultry products should have the manufacturing date on the immediate container. If coded, explain each code on the export certificate. Meat and poultry products must reach Lebanon within 180 days of slaughter.

Certification Requirements

1. Obtain FSIS Form 9060-5--Export Certificate of Wholesomeness.
2. Include slaughter dates and expiration dates in the "remarks" section of FSIS Form 9060-5. Meat and poultry products must reach Lebanon within 180 days of slaughter.
3. An import permit is required for fresh (unfrozen) poultry meat. Imports of frozen meat, frozen poultry (including livers) no longer need a prior import license.

Plants Eligible to Export

All federally inspected establishments are eligible to export to Lebanon.

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
