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# **Export Requirements for Morocco**

## **Eligible/Ineligible Products**

### **A. Eligible**

1. Red meat and meat products
2. Poultry and poultry products.
3. Meat and poultry exports to Morocco requires an import license from the Ministry of Commerce. Importers obtain the import license following approval by the Ministry of Agriculture. U.S. exporters interested in sending products to Morocco should contact their importer for a copy of the import permit.

### **B. Ineligible**

1. Restrictions on poultry and poultry products raised or processed in Texas have been removed.\*

## **Documentation Requirements**

- A. For red meat products, obtain FSIS Form 9060-5 (7/19-2001) - Export Certificate of Wholesomeness.
- B. For poultry products, obtain FSIS Form 9060-5 and FSIS Form 9352-1 - Veterinary Certificate for Poultry Meat Exported into Morocco.
- C. Signature on certificates - All required forms and supplementary statements must be dated and signed by an FSIS veterinarian (name, degree [DVM or equivalent], must be typed after the signature).
- D. Ritual Slaughter - A certificate of Islamic (Halal) Slaughter must accompany shipments labeled "Halal." Animals must be slaughtered in accordance with Islamic law.

## **Plants Eligible to Export**

All Federally inspected meat plants are eligible to export to Morocco.

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
