### **EXPORT REQUIREMENTS FOR URUGUAY**

#### **ELIGIBLE/INELIGIBLE**

##### **A. Eligible**

###### **1. Pork**

a. Fresh/frozen pork and pork products

b. Pork fat

###### **2. Beef trachea**

###### **3. Sweetbreads**

###### **4. Pork casings**

##### **B. Ineligible**

1. Poultry and poultry products are ineligible for export to Uruguay at this time. References to poultry have been retained elsewhere in these requirements for information, but this does not imply eligibility of poultry at this time.

Note: Poultry products for ship stores remains eligible if certified according to the DOCUMENTATION section.\*

### **DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS**

#### **A. Certification Requirements**

##### **1. For all pork product and pork fat:**

a. Obtain FSIS Form 9060-5. Include the following statements in the "Remarks" section:

*"The animals from which the product was obtained originated from farms that are free of O.I. E. List A diseases that affect swine." "The animals from which the product was obtained were slaughtered in official establishments with permanent veterinary inspection and are fit for human consumption."*

2. For poultry meat:

a. Obtain FSIS Form 9060-5. Include the following statements in the "Remarks" section:

*"The birds were slaughtered in approved USDA establishments and ante- and post-mortem examinations did not show infectious or parasitic disease; The poultry comes from farms which are in good standing with respect to poultry salmonellosis according to the United States National Poultry Improvement Program, which is the national plan for controlling poultry diseases; The U.S. is free of velogenic Newcastle disease; and the birds are fit for human consumption."*

3. For beef trachea for pharmaceutical use - Obtain FSIS Form 9060-9. Include the following statements in both English and Spanish in the "Remarks" section:

*"The frozen bovine trachea comes from healthy animals and that before slaughtering they did not have any symptoms of infectious diseases."*

4. For sweetbreads - Obtain FSIS Form 9060-5. It is the responsibility of the exporter to provide a Spanish translation of information provided on this form including the certification statement. Translated information will not be signed by the inspector.

5. Pork Casings - Obtain FSIS Form 9060-18 Animal Casings Export Certificate for Countries Requiring Ante-Mortem, Post-Mortem and Sound and Clean Statements.

6. Poultry product for ship stores - Obtain FSIS Form 9060-5 (7-19-2001), Export Certificate of Wholesomeness. Additionally, the following statement must be typed in the "Remarks" section of FSIS 9060-5:\*

*"Product for ship stores. This product originated from birds slaughtered and processed in a State free of exotic Newcastle disease."\**

7. All required forms and letterhead statements must be dated and signed by an FSIS veterinarian (name, degree [DVM or equivalent] must be typed after the signature).

## PLANTS ELIGIBLE TO EXPORT

All Federally inspected meat establishments are eligible to export to Uruguay

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
