Background

1. At the last 39th Session of the CCFH the Committee had considered the Report of the *Ad Hoc* Working Group for Establishment of CCFH Work Priorities (for details of consideration see ALINORM 08/39/13, paras 155-172).
2. Based on recommendation of the Working Group, the Committee agreed to take up new work on commodity specific annexes for the Code of Hygienic Practice for Fresh Fruit and Vegetables and on a Code of Hygienic Practice for *Vibrio* spp. in Seafood pending approval by the 31st Session of the Commission.
3. The Committee accepted the offer of the Delegation of India to lead the work on the development of the Risk Analysis Policy of the CCFH and agreed that the work would proceed via electronic working group in future.

4. The Committee agreed to re-establish the *Ad-Hoc* Working Group for Establishment of CCFH Work Priorities that would meet the day before the next Session (30 November 2008) and accepted the offer of the delegation of France to Chair the Working Group.

5. Member Governments are invited to propose new work to be considered by the *Ad Hoc* Working Group convened before the 40th Session and should do it in accordance with the Criteria for the Establishment of Work Priorities (see Procedural Manual, 17th Edition) and according to the process described in Appendix V of ALINORM 07/30/13 to the addresses indicated above. The deadline for proposals – 1 August 2008.
