## LETTERHEAD CERTIFICATE FOR THE EXPORT OF PORK LARD AND/OR PORK TISSUES TO COLOMBIA

1. The origin country is free from Foot and Mouth Disease, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, Teschen Disease, and hog cholera.
2. The product was obtained from animals born, raised and fed in the United States or Canada.
3. The slaughtered animals came from holdings that are not under official quarantine or restrictive movement of animals for control or eradication of livestock diseases affecting swine.
4. The product was obtained from animals given both ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection and found that they were in good health conditions.
5. The product was produced in a process whose temperatures exceed 100 degrees Celsius.
6. The processing plant is under official sanitary control.
7. Microbiological tests done on dehydrated representative samples of the product showed negative to pathogens.
8. This product is consumed without restrictions in the exporting country and therefore it does not represent a risk (of infection) for human and animal health.
