Letterhead Certificate For Export Of Beef, Mutton, Their Edible By-Products and Casings To Thailand

1. The United States has been free from Foot-and-Mouth disease and Rinderpest for twelve months preceding the slaughter of the animals and up to the time of export.
2. The animals are born and reared in the United States or have been in the United States for not less than 4 months. (NOTE: Animals originating in Canada are regarded as American for the purpose of export to Thailand).
3. The products have been processed in a designated establishment in a sanitary manner under constant veterinary supervision and derived from animals which received ante-mortem and post-mortem examinations and found free from diseases.
4. The products do not contain preservatives, additives, or other substances at a level harmful to human health.
5. The products are fit for human consumption and every precaution has been taken to prevent contamination prior to export.
6. The products have not been stored for more than 3 months.
7. The United States meets or exceeds all of the international guidelines to be considered free of BSE.
