PREPARATION OF FSIS 8080-1. NOTICE OF DETENTION

The program employee enters the following information:

PRODUCT CONTROL NUMBER - The number automatically generated in AssuranceNet/In Commerce System.

DATE DETAINED - The date product was detained.

OWNER'S NAME, ADDRESS, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER - Enter the full organization name or individual, address and telephone number of the owner of the detained product.

CUSTODIAN'S NAME, ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE NUMBER - Enter the full organization name, address, and telephone number of the custodian of the detained product.

SECTION 1. DESCRIPTION AND NUMBER OF ARTICLE(S) DETAINED

A. Product Name - Enter the product species and name. When multiple products are involved enter "Various" (beef, poultry, pork and goat). Each item should be listed separately in blocks A, B, C, D, E, and F. In instances where inventories are not available use "Various."

NOTE: If additional space is needed, place an asterisk in the appropriate section followed by the statement "See attached sheet(s)."

- B. Coding Enter any stamped, stenciled, handwritten or otherwise applied numerical or alphabetical characters which appear to be some type of product/production code.
- C. Number Enter number of units, e.g., cases, pkgs, dozens
- D. Product Weight Enter approximate net weight of detention action in pounds. For Shell Eggs enter the number of dozens.
- E. Condition Check appropriate block.
- F. Est. Number Enter Federal or State Est. number. If the detention involves egg product, prefix the establishment number with "EGG".
- G. Inspection Type Check appropriate block.

Block 2. LOCATION OF DETAINED ARTICLE(S) - Enter the full organizational name and address (including zip code) where product is detained. If same as owner and/or custodian, enter "same as owner and/or custodian."

Block 3. DETENTION

- A. Code The program employee will enter a 4 character code based on the listing shown below: The specific positions (characters) within the code denote respectively:
 - 1st character indicates meat, poultry, both, or egg, (M = Meat, P = Poultry, B = Both, or E = Egg).
 - 2nd character indicates the type of product: Domestic or Imported,
 (D = Domestic, I = Illegal entry/imported products includes ineligible countries products).
 - 3rd character indicates adulterated or misbranded, or Shell Egg A = Adulterated, M = Misbranded, S = Shell Egg)
 - 4th character indicates the specific reason or cause of the adulteration, misbranding, or Shell Egg detention.

Adulteration

- Bears or contains any harmful or unauthorized chemical substance such as sulfites, curing agents, coloring agents, etc.
- 2) Bears or contains unauthorized ingredients which would increase weight such as water, soy products, etc.
- Bears or contains any extraneous material such as rodent or insect droppings, glass, bone, metal, hair, etc.
- 4) Consists of any sour, putrid, or moldy substance.
- 5) Other (Specify) Illegal entry/imported products, ineligible countries, etc.), if adulterated.

Block 3. DETENTION (Continued)

Misbranded

- 1) Void of any labeling.
- Contains excessive amounts of authorized ingredients or does not conform to standards of composition.
- 3) Contains false, misleading, or incomplete labeling such as an incomplete ingredients statement, missing inspection marks, etc., or illegible labels or brands.
- 4) Un-inspected product represented as inspected.
- 5) Non-federally inspected (NFI) product transported in commerce.
- 6) Inedible product improperly labeled or identified such as un-denatured inedible products.
- 7) Failure to remove official marks of inspection.
- 8) Entered NFI product into an official Est.
- 9) Other (specify) Illegal entry/imported products, ineligible countries, etc.), if not-adulterated.

Shell Egg

- 1) Shell Egg Temperature
- 2) Shell Egg Labeling
- B. Reason Check appropriate block.
- C. Detention Description Enter appropriate wording which briefly summarizes the description of the noncompliance. (See below)

NOTE: When preparing FSIS Form 8080-1, Notice of Detention, be advised that the use of the term **"non-federally"** is not acceptable in **block 3C** (Detention Description).

The terms "misbranded" and/or "adulterated" with qualification are acceptable. Some examples of qualification are:

"Misbranded" - No marks of Federal inspection

"Misbranded" - Bears inaccurate labeling

"Misbranded" - Product contains ingredient not shown on label"Misbranded" - Product "represented" to be inspected and passed

"Adulterated" - Sour - Putrid

"Adulterated" - Rancid

"Adulterated" - Hair and dirt

"Adulterated" - Gassy, odorous

"Adulterated" - Swollen cans, (not overfill)

"Adulterated" - Contaminated with foreign material

"Adulterated" - Product contains ingredient not permitted

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The examples above will cover approximately 95% of the detentions made. Other reasons include:

"Shell Egg" - Temperature
"Shell Egg" - Labeling

"Inedible" - Not properly labeled; Inedible not slashed and/or denatured
"Imported Product" - Refused entry, illegally imported, ineligible country products, etc.

SECTION 4. DETAINED TAG(S) ATTACHED

- A. Number(s) Enter the number of each detained tag used.
- B. Time Enter the time detained tags were applied.

Block 5. LEGAL AUTHORITY FOR DETENTION - Check appropriate box. For other products, check "Other" and specify appropriate statutory reference.

Block 6. NAME & ADDRESS OF SHIPPER - Enter full organizational name and address of firm or individual responsible for offering the product for transportation in commerce. If same as owner, enter "same as owner."

Block 7. NAME & ADDRESS OF SELLER - Enter full organizational name and address of firm or individual who offered the product for sale. If same as owner, enter "same as owner."

Block 8. POINT OF SHIPMENT - Enter the location (city/state) where the shipment originated.

Block 9. TRANSPORTER - Enter the carrier (company name or individual) of product, if applicable

Block 10. PRODUCT SAMPLED - Check appropriate block. When a sample is obtained from detained product, submit a copy of the laboratory report form with the case. Always pay for samples obtained.

Block 11. FREEZER LOT NUMBER - Enter lot number provided by a responsible individual if applicable or enter "N/A."

Block 12. NAME OF OWNER/OWNER'S AGENT NOTIFIED- Print or type the name of the individual contacted at time of detention.

Block 13. SIGNATURE - Obtain a signature from the responsible individual (same as printed in 12) contacted at time of detention.

Block 14. NAME(S) AND ADDRESS (ES) OF FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL AUTHORITIES NOTIFIED- Enter names and addresses of other agencies notified of the detention action, if any (FDA, APHIS, State Health Department, County Health Department).

Block 15. SIGNATURE OF AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF USDA

- A. Signature of USDA authorized representative (program employee).
- B. Badge # Enter program employee badge number.
- C. Telephone Number Enter program employee office telephone number.
- D. Address Enter complete program employee office address.

Block 16. OWNER NOTIFICATION

- A. Date owner notified Enter the date the program employee notified the owner of the detention action.
- B. Owner informed by Check appropriate block(s). Telephone (TEL), certified mail (CM), hand delivered (HD), facsimile (FAX).
- C. Name of owner/owner's agent notified Print or type the name of the individual contacted.

Note: After completing the forms for the product control action (detention and/or termination), in the ICS system, the program employee will notify the appropriate FSIS Field Supervisory Office of the detention action. If the product control action (Notice of Detention and/or Termination, etc.) is associated to an investigation, the program employee is to link the product control action to the associated investigation in the ICS system.

When product control documentation (Notice of Detention and/or Termination, etc.) is sent via Certified Mail to the product owner, attach a scanned copy(s) into the ICS system and include a copy(s) of the mailed documents in the associated case file.
