

**VETERINARY CERTIFICATE FOR EXPORT OF POULTRY**  
*(For Export To Fiji)*

**PART I**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, a registered veterinary surgeon of the USDA, Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS), after due inquiries certify that:

1. The chicken were subjected to antemortem and postmortem inspections in an official USDA registered abattoir and found to be free of contagious and infectious disease and passed as fit for human consumption.
2. Chicken allowed for slaughter are done so in compliance with the Poultry Inspection Act and the Code of Regulation Act.
3. Levels of residues in the carcasses are within the tolerance level of the United States of America's National Residue Program.

**PART II**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, an official veterinary surgeon of the USDA, FSIS after due inquiries have no reason to doubt and certify as correct the declaration/certification in the attached Veterinary Certificate provided by the plant; and with Part I, above, and further certify that all other conditions stipulated below have been met.

1. The United States of America is free of Velogenic and Pathogenic strains of the Mesogenic Newcastle Disease Virus in its commercial poultry flock.
2. The poultry products shall be wrapped in Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved wrapping material, with the date of slaughter applied and containing other information required under the US Poultry Products Inspection Act.
3. The wrapped carcass shall be packed in clean cartons and sealed with tamper proof labelling material.
4. In case of exotic disease outbreak in the USA, immediate prohibition of export to Fiji will be put in place.
