Dear Ms. Hauter:

The Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) has received the petition you submitted on behalf of Food and Water Watch dated December 6, 2017. The petition requests that FSIS remove Brazil as a country eligible to export meat products to the United States under 9 CFR 327.2(b). The petition asserts that findings from FSIS's audits of Brazil's meat inspection system over the past 16 years, along with findings of corruption by Brazil's own law enforcement authorities, demonstrate that Brazil no longer meets the criteria for equivalency with USDA's meat inspection system.

Your request is being considered as a rulemaking petition under the Administrative Procedure Act (5 U.S.C. 553(e)), USDA's administrative regulations (7 CFR 1.28), and FSIS's regulations on petitions (9 CFR part 392). Your petition has been referred to the Office of Policy and Program Development for review, and it has been assigned petition number 17-08.
