Product Name Qualifying Statement (QS) Required?	No qualifier is needed, however, words such as “seasoned” or “flavored” are included in the product name	Yes
QS Location	Must be part of the product name.	Must be prominent and conspicuous which means it is in close proximity or contiguous to the product name
QS Format	May be of a different size, style, color or type, but in all cases, the words must be prominent, conspicuous and legible	May be of a different size, style, color or type than that of the product name.
QS Minimum Lettering or Font Size	1/3 size of the largest letter in the product name.	1/4 size of the largest letter in the product name.
Percent (%) Added Solution Required to be Declared on the Label?	No	.Yes
Solution Ingredients Required to be Listed in Either the DD or QS?	No	No – but ingredients of the solution may accompany the QS. If the ingredients in the solution are included in the QS, they must appear in print 1/8 size of the most prominent letter in the product name.
Example(s) - Acceptable Product Name(s)	Seasoned Fillet of Roast Beef	Black Pepper Beef, Contains a 27% Solution OR Roast Beef Contains up to 20% of a Solution
