Laptop Basics - Parts of Your Laptop

Please locate these
features on your laptop

Touch Screen

Trackpad



Laptop Control Options

Trackpad (yellow)

Touchscreen

Pointing Stick (red)

Option to connect a personal mouse



Laptop Basics - Parts of Your Laptop

Tip: The cord will light up blue when it is plugged in

Plug in power cord here



Connect MiFi Device

If you received a MiFi device:

Plug in device

Turn on the device

Tip: If you have another network source available (establishment/home), it is allowed and advised to use that source instead of the MiFi for the best connection



Turn on the Laptop

Press the Power button

Be sure the laptop is plugged in first



Laptop Logon

When prompted, at the same time, press the CTRL-ALT-DELETE keys



Log Into the Laptop

Enter the username and password



View the Desktop

Connect to the Internet

If you have access to a
hardwire connection, plug in
the network cable here



Connect to the Internet

Wi-Fi



Audio Options

Use laptop speakers
(default)



Audio Options

Use personal headphones

To ask a verbal question, you will need to use a headphones with a mic or unplug them and use the computer mic



Adjust Audio Volume

While pressing the function (Fn) key, press the F2 or F3 key to decrease or increase the volume. You will see the volume level appear in the upper left of your screen.



Adjust Screen Brightness

While pressing the function (Fn) key, press the F11 or F12 key to decrease or increase the brightness



Rules for Using the Training Laptop

- Treat laptop/MiFi as any other FSIS property
- Keep the shipping box and packaging materials to use for the return shipping
- Keep your laptop/MiFi charged/plugged in
- Laptop has limited capabilities
 - No email (no eVPN connection)
 - Internet limited to FSIS training websites
