 - (6) wild non-domestic animals of the order *Artiodactyla* (excluding bovine animals (including *Bison* and *Bubalus* species and their cross-breeds), *Ovis aries*, *Capra hircus*, *Suidae* and *Tayassuidae*), and of the families *Rhinocerotidae* and *Elephantidae* (Model 'RUW');
 - (7) farmed non-domestic animals belonging to the *Suidae, Tayassuidae*, or *Tapiridae* families (Model 'SUF');
 - (8) wild non-domestic animals belonging to the *Suidae*, *Tayassuidae*, or *Tapiridae* families (Model 'SUW'):
 - (9) wild solipeds belonging to the subgenus *Hippotigris* (zebra) (Model 'EQW').

Fresh meat means all animal parts fit for human consumption whether fresh, chilled or frozen.
