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User Guide for the FSIS Repeat Residue Violator List:

Repeat Violator: This is an individual or firm selling an animal for slaughter whose carcass is found to contain a violative level of a drug, pesticide, or other chemical residue within 12 months after receiving a FSIS Violation Notification Letter. The 12-month listing period on the Residue Repeat Violator List (RRVL) will begin once a second violation has been confirmed.

Part II: Residue Repeat Violator List (RRVL) for Use by Livestock Markets and Establishments

This list has been designed to facilitate its use by establishments and livestock markets. This list identifies all suppliers with more than one residue violation in a rolling 12-month window. The 12-month listing period on the RRVL will begin once a second violation has been confirmed.

The names and addresses of violators will remain on the list for at least a year from the time of being listed. The website will be updated as violations are confirmed, and the names of the violators will be deleted once the 12-month period has passed from the last violation. For subsequent violations, the time will be extended by a year from when the additional violation is confirmed.

Slaughter establishments and livestock auctions can use this list to determine whether a producer has more than one residue violation attributed to it within the last 12 months. This list is also available in Excel format.
