1. The beef and/or beef product is derived from bovine animals that were slaughtered in the U.S., Canada or _____, and were processed/manufactured in the USA or Canada in federally registered and inspected establishments.
2. The beef and/or beef products have been produced in accordance with the OIE standard relevant to the trade in the product certified.
3. The products do not contain any specified risk materials (SRMs).
4. Foot and mouth disease and rinderpest have not occurred in Canada and/or the United States of America during the twelve months immediately prior to manufacture of the products.
5. The products do not contain any specified risk materials (SRMs) which include tonsils, intestines, brains, eyes, spinal cord, skull and vertebral column (and protein products derived thereof), from bovine animals.
6. The products were derived from animals that passed ante-mortem and post-mortem veterinary inspection at the time of slaughter and were processed in premises under the supervision of the controlling authority and in accordance with Canadian and/or United States regulations.
7. The products are sound and fit for human consumption.
