<p>II.1 Animal Health Attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify, that the animal casings described above:</p> <p>(a) come from plants approved by the competent authority;</p> <p>⁽¹⁾(b) have been cleaned, scraped and:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">⁽²⁾either salted with NaCl for 30 days</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">⁽²⁾or bleached</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">⁽²⁾or dried after scraping</p> <p>(c) have undergone all precautions to avoid recontamination after treatment.</p> <p>II.2 Public Health Attestation</p> <p>II.2.1 if containing material from bovine, ovine or caprine animals, the intestines used in the preparation of casings shall be subject to the following conditions depending on the BSE risk category of the country of origin:</p> <p>⁽²⁾II.2.1.1 For imports from a country or a region with a negligible BSE risk as listed in Annex to Commission Decision 2007/453/EC as amended;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. the country or region is classified in accordance with Decision 2007/453/EC as a country or region posing a negligible BSE risk; 2. the animals from which the products of bovine, ovine and caprine animal origin were derived passed ante mortem and post mortem inspections; ⁽²⁾⁽³⁾ 3. the products of bovine, ovine and caprine animal origin do not contain and are not derived from specified risk material as defined in point I of Annex V to Regulation (EC) No. 999/2001; ⁽²⁾ 4. the products of bovine, ovine and caprine animal origin do not contain and are not derived from mechanically separated meat obtained from bones of bovine, ovine or caprine animals, except if the animals, from which the products of bovine, ovine and caprine animal origin are derived, were born, continuously reared and slaughtered in a country or region classified in accordance with Decision 2007/453/EC as a country or region posing a negligible BSE risk in which there has been no BSE indigenous cases; ⁽²⁾ 5. the animals from which the products of bovine, ovine and caprine animal origin were derived have not been slaughtered after stunning by means of gas injected into the cranial cavity or killed by the same method or slaughtered by laceration after stunning of central nervous tissue by means of an elongated rod-shaped instrument introduced into the cranial cavity, except if the animals from which the products of bovine, ovine and caprine animal origin are derived, were born, continuously reared and slaughtered in a country or region classified in accordance with Decision 2007/453/EC as a country or region posing a negligible BSE risk; <p>Notes</p> <p>Part I</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Box reference I.15: Registration number (railway wagons or container and lorries), flight number (aircraft) or name (ship).
