Abit, owner, Triple A Foods and Cosmetics, entered a guilty plea to charges of selling rodent adulterated poultry products in commerce in violation of the PPIA. Mr. Abit faces a maximum penalty of 3 years in prison and a \$10,000 fine at sentencing scheduled for October 31, 2008.
AMERICAN DISPATCH, INC. PITTSBURGH, PA	10/09/07				On October 9, 2007, the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania indicted American Dispatch, Inc., on 1 felony count for transporting, selling and offering for sale approximately 2,814 pounds of meat and meat food products into commerce, that were contaminated by a putrid substance, and were unwholesome, unfit for human food, and adulterated, as defined in Title 21, United States Code Section 601(m) (3).
FOUAD ISLAMBOULI JERSEY CITY, NJ		3/12/08	3/12/08	07/17/08	On July 17, 2008, in the United States District Court, District of New Jersey, Mr. Fouad Islambouli, partner in Provision Halal Distributors, was sentenced for the sale of adulterated meat in violation of the FMIA. Mr. Islambouli was ordered to pay a fine of \$1,000, a special assessment fee of \$25, and was placed on probation for 2 years. This action was the result of an investigation by FSIS with assistance from USDA Office of Inspector General, Investigations.

Mr. Che had been charged with preparing and selling in commerce, non-federally inspected meat and poultry products for re-sale. The agreement stipulates that any person purchasing product from the firm is required to sign a declaration stating they will not re-sell the product.
KING PAO GROCERY HUEI CHEN WANG AND TAIFU WANG, OWNERS WAYNE, NJ	05/19/08	08/15/08	On August 15, 2008, in the United States District Court, District of New Jersey, signed a consent order permanently enjoining King Pao Grocery, in Wayne, New Jersey and co-owners Huei Chen Wang, and Taifu Wang from violating Section 10 of the FMIA, and Section 9 of the PPIA, by offering for sale/selling, offering for transportation, or receiving in commerce, any uninspected and misbranded meat or poultry products.
