

Completion Instructions

FSIS Form 9060-5S (Fish and Fish Products Export Certificate of Wholesomeness)

Block 1: *Country of Destination* - Enter the name of the intended receiving country.

Block 2: *ISO Code* - Enter the two-letter alpha ISO code of the intended receiving country listed in block 1.

Block 3: *Consignor/Exporter* - Enter the applicant's (exporter/consignor) name and address including zip code. This block is intended to identify the exporter or consignor. This is usually the owner and/or exporter of the product. In some cases, the applicant plant may own the product and also be the consignor.

Block 4: *Consignee/Importer* - Consignee/ Importer's name and physical address including zip code. The consignee/importer is located in the country of destination. Check that the consignee/importer address is in the same country listed in the "Country of Destination" box.

Block 5: *Certificate Number* - Pre-printed MP serial number for FSIS Form 9060-5 or the pre-printed CF serial number for FSIS Form 9060-5S.

Block 6: *Certificate Type* - Select Original or Replacement as appropriate.

Block 7: *Export Est. No.* - Enter the number, name, and address of the establishment where the product is exported from. This is usually where the product is stamped for export.

Block 8: *Total Net Weight* - Enter the total net weight of the shipment. Check that the total net weight equals the combined marked net weight of each individual lot of product.

Block 9: *Total Number of Packages* - Enter the total number of shipping containers (corresponds with the type of packages in lot, block 14) in the shipment. Check that total number of packages equals the combined total number of packages in each lot.

Block 10: *Description of Product (Name of Product)* - Enter the name of the product as it appears on the label of the immediate container(s).

Block 11: *Net Weight of Lot* - Enter the total marked net weight for each individual lot of product.

Block 12: *Species* - Enter the species of the product in the lot (*Siluriformes Fish*).

Block 13: *Number of Packages in Lot* - Enter the total number of packages of each individual lot of product (combos, cartons, drums, boxes, cases, etc.).

Block 14: *Type of Packages in Lot* - Enter the type of packages in each lot of product, corresponding with item 19 of the export application (e.g. combos, cartons, drums, boxes, cases, etc.).

Block 15: *Shipping Marks/Lot Numbers* - Enter the lot number or production code and any shipping marks used by the establishment to identify product. Check the export library to determine if the importing country requires shipping marks, company seals, or transport vessel numbers. This information is not required unless indicated as such in the FSIS export library.

Block 16: *Est./Plant Number on Product* - Enter the U.S. establishment number marked on the shipping cartons/containers of the product intended for export.

Block 17: *Remarks* - Enter only the information or certification statements specified in the export library for the importing country. The information or certification statements must be exactly as specified in the FSIS export library.

Block 18: *Attestation* - Checking the box attests that the fish products in the shipment meet FSIS requirements and are eligible for commerce.

Block 19: *Certifying Official's Name and Title* - The certifying official should sign the certificate using any color other than black ink, type or print their name and their district number and if the importing country requires a PHV signature, include his or her professional degree, e.g. DVM.

Block 20: *Date Signed* - The date the FSIS Form 9060-5S is signed.
