### FSIS Letterhead Certificate for Egg Products to India

1. A. The egg products were derived from shell eggs:

- from birds that were kept in a county free of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) and Newcastle Disease, as defined by the OIE; and
- that are received in containers and packing or packaging materials free from odors and materials which could contaminate or adulterate the eggs or egg products.

OR

- B. The product has been pasteurized or heat treated according to USDA regulations, sufficient to inactivate the avian influenza viruses and Newcastle disease, as defined by the OIE.

AND

2. The means of transport, handling, and loading conditions of the products comply with the hygiene requirements of the United States including the necessary precautions to avoid product contamination with Newcastle disease and avian influenza viruses.
