

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## Import Library: Eligible Countries and Products

Asterisks (\*) indicate where the most recent revision was made. To search, click on your browser's "Edit" menu, then click on "Find (on this page)". Enter "\*" in the "Find What" field, then click "Find" or "Find Next" until all asterisks have been identified.

The Import Library identifies eligible products using the Process Category, Product Category and Eligible Products listed in the FSIS Product Categorization document, and utilized in the Public Health Information System (PHIS). In addition, the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service [7] (APHIS) applicable disease restrictions will be referenced on individual country pages.

- Process Category: High-level category based on whether and how products are processed after slaughter.
- Product Category: More specific category that links the product to the appropriate species and provides more information on the production process.
- Eligible Products: Listing of the most detailed grouping of eligible products Product Groups that are used by FSIS to program appropriate types of inspections in FSIS' PHIS. Eligible products are from a country that the United States (U.S.) has already determined to have an equivalent meat, poultry, or egg product inspection systems.

Source materials used to produce finished products for export to the U.S. must come from an approved source. An approved source is meat or poultry carcasses or products or processed egg products from an eligible country and certified establishment.

APHIS Restricted Products: Products that are restricted by APHIS are identified with a "±". To see the APHIS disease status and the applicable species, click on the APHIS web page link at the bottom of the country page.

- Identify all equivalent countries listed the Code of Federal Regulations in two tables
  - (1) Eligible Countries who are recognized as eligible to export to the U.S.

These are the Process Categories, Product Categories, and Product Groups as defined in the Public Health Information System (PHIS).

- RTE = Ready-to-eat; NRTE = Not ready-to-eat
- For raw poultry products, poultry includes the following species: chicken, turkey, duck, geese, guineas, and squab.
- For raw ratite products, ratites includes emu, ostrich, and rhea.
- For processed meat products, meat includes the following species: beef, veal, goat, lamb, mutton, and pork.
- For processed poultry products, poultry includes the following species: chicken, duck, goose, guinea, squab, turkey, emu, ostrich, and rhea.
- Egg products includes the following species: chicken, turkey, duck, goose, and guinea.

**Beef** and **Veal** imported from Canada are subjected to the Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) requirements specified in 9 CFR 94.20 [2].

Lamb and Goat imported from Canada are subject to the requirements in 9 CFR 94.25
