1. The pork, pork products, or pork offals were derived from swine that were born, raised, or legally imported, and slaughtered in the United States, or were derived from pork meat products that were legally imported into the United States from a country with an equivalent food safety system.
2. The United States is free of foot-and-mouth disease without vaccination, classical swine fever, African swine fever, and swine vesicular disease.
3. The pork and pork products bear the official USDA Mark of Inspection;
 - i. That identifies the producing FSIS establishment number;
 - ii. Provides the assurance that the product was produced under FSIS inspection in compliance with all Federal statutes and regulations for food safety and sanitation;
 - iii. Passed FSIS ante-mortem and post mortem inspection showing no signs of systemic disease or infection; and
 - iv. Is fit for human consumption, is freely sold in the United States and eligible for export.
4. The pork, pork products, and pork offals were hygienically handled while under FSIS jurisdiction.
