1. The United States is free from foot-and-mouth disease.
2. The beef and beef products (bone-in or boneless) were derived from cattle that were either born in the United States or legally imported.
3. The United States complies with the conditions in the Terrestrial Animal Health Code of the OIE as a country that presents a Negligible Risk for bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE).
4. The cattle from which the fresh meat and meat products destined for export to the Turks and Caicos Islands were derived were not subjected to a pithing process.
5. The feeding of ruminants with ruminant origin meat-and-bone meal or greaves is prohibited in the United States.
